I received a page this evening from Naomi's nurse, Mindy Weed, regarding Naomi's parents wanting to speak to me.

I spoke to Ms. Burns first, who had questions regarding Naomi's retinal hemorrhages. Ms. Burns stated that what was reported by Det. Arntz, Brighton PD, this afternoon "was different" than what was reported by the ophthalmology team. I asked Ms. Burns what they were told by ophthalmology and Ms. Burns passed the phone to Mr. Burns. Please note that I spoke to Mr. and Ms. Burns on Ms. Weed's phone; no speaker mode.

Mr. Burns stated that the ophthalmologist told them that Naomi's retinal hemorrhages were "in the back of her eye." I relayed that Naomi's retinal hemorrhages were noted outside of the posterior pole and into the periphery ("360 degrees"). I said that I could see how the "back of the eye" may lead Mr. and Ms. Burns to think that he hemorrhages were in a smaller area in the posterior pole of the eyes.

I relayed that Naomi's hemorrhages are most suspicious for physical abuse.

Mr. Burns asked if they needed a lawyer based on what Ms. Burns relayed to him from her interaction with Det. Arntz.

Mr. Burns said that Naomi's brain MRI was read as benign fluid during her first admission. I told Mr. Burns that the initial MRI was read incorrectly. I advised Mr. Burns to discuss this further with Dr. Murphy; as Dr. Murphy and I had discussed contacting risk management regarding this issue.

Mr. Burns said that he and Ms. Burns would like to review all of Naomi's records. I asked Ms. Weed to assist Mr. and Ms. Burns in filling out the request for medical records form and sending this to medical records; and to, specifically, request a CD of Naomi's UMHS imaging if desired.

I told Mr. Burns to have me paged if he or Ms. Burns have any further questions.

Please note that I spoke to Det. Arntz, Brighton PD, this morning prior to his contact with Mr. and Ms. Burns this afternoon.
