- 3: When you told the doctors at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital about the incident on March 15<sup>th</sup>, were you truthful? **Answer- YES**

**Test Two**

**Relevant Issue Test Questions:**

- 1: Since Naomi's birth, have there been injuries to her that have not been reported?  
**Answer- NO**
- 2: Since her birth, has Naomi experienced physical trauma that has not been reported?  
**Answer- NO**
- 3: Other than the March 15<sup>th</sup> event, are you aware of any other injuries to Naomi?  
**Answer- NO**
